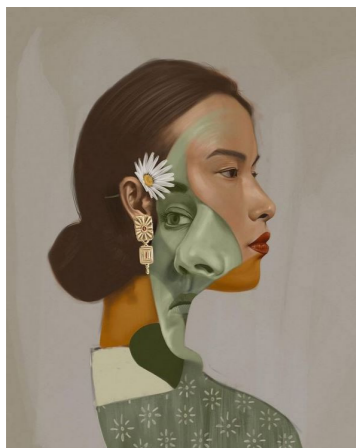

On personal education, and creative education viewed locally and globally

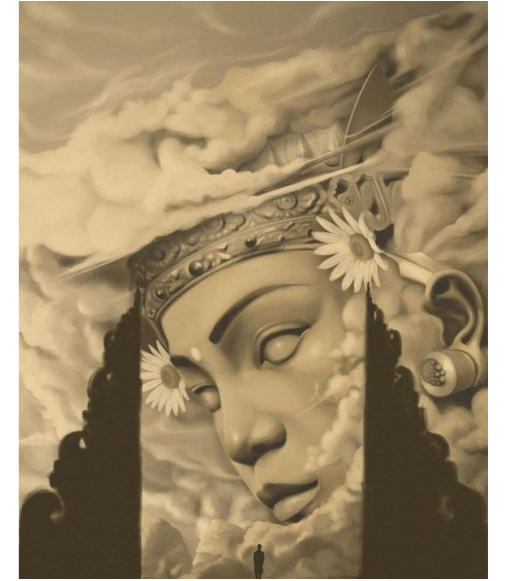


I never finished my education in arts, for some time I majored in design and even then I didn't get to the end of it.
