I started as a self-tough artist until I decided to make it a career, so I entered a high school specialized in art and then I took a course of drawing and painting but I have always kept my style.

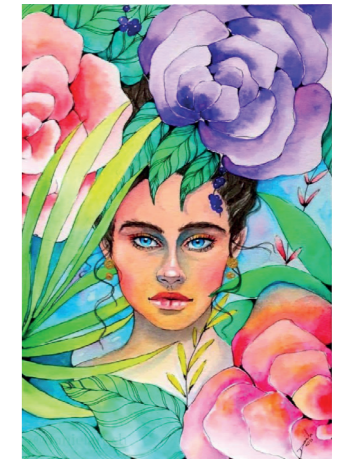
On personal education, and creative education viewed locally and globally
